

# MHRN - Hijacking Dissent

## John Stokes Sessionist Movement

In May of 1994, the Montana Human Rights Network published a report titled [A Season of Discontent: Militias, Constitutionalists, and the Far Right](#). Was that report just a coincidence of timing with John Stokes and his wife Pam moving to Kalispell, Montana from Washington State? Not likely.

While in Washington, Stokes was involved in a [county sessionist movement](#).

Before moving to Montana in 1994, Stokes spearheaded what is known as the "county secessionist movement" in Washington State. He and his followers tried to establish new counties that they believed would allow them to circumvent land-use laws. The movement combined issues of property rights with the traditional anti-government movement. In 1998, the Washington Supreme Court ruled this secessionist movement could not force the Washington Legislature to create new counties.

One of the counties that Stokes attempted to create, Freedom County, made headlines in October 2000 when officers were sworn in for this non-existent county. The current leader of Freedom County is Thom Satterlee, a man who has tried to file bogus freemen documents in Washington and is linked to the Washington State Militia. Freedom County's "sheriff" refuses to pay income taxes, obtain a driver's license or use a social security number. All of these are traditional freemen practices.

. . . In 1994, he handed out fliers at a planning meeting, titled "Boycott Utopian Socialist Planners." It encouraged people to avoid businesses who gave money to "Eco freak socialist" groups. He said businesses would be given ten days to withdraw their support from the "socialist Master Plan" or they would be included on a boycott list to be distributed to the public.

. . . A May 3, 1997, article in Everett, Washington's The Herald says both Stokes and Satterlee **petitioned the United Nations** to step in and help form the new county. A Herald reporter says Stokes remained active in the movement after moving to Montana.

If that doesn't ring a sour note, I don't know what would. Apparently there was [dissent](#) on involvement by the UN.

Beyond appearances and perceptions, it seems highly unlikely that the group of men Stokes was involved with in Washington State were not at least unofficially sanctioned as social engineers because in 1991, the governments of Alaska, Montana, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, British Columbia, Alberta and the Yukon Territory voted to establish [an international economic region](#). The region is a public-private partnership between business and government. The [Pacific Northwest Economic Region \(PNWER\)](#) is defined in [Idaho Statutes 67-7803](#). The PNWER was a move towards globalization and the end of the nation-state system of organization.

To accomplish the establishment of an international economic region means redefining or erasing jurisdictional boundaries. Clearly that's what John Stokes and his fellow conspirators were doing in Washington State and what the [conspirators in Oregon](#) are doing now.

The reorganization of American jurisdictional boundaries defined in law is a stealth administrative tactic to accomplish world government under the organizing hub of the United Nations. Redefinition of legal jurisdictions disempowers American citizens by redefining their country right out from under them. That's where communist/marxist **human rights** like the Montana Human Rights Network come into the picture. Human rights is a communist United Nations concept. It is the inverse from U.S. Constitutional Rights. Constitutional rights limit government power over the people. Human rights are "gifted rights" that can be taken away at any time.

The agendas of John Stokes and the MHRN are not connected on the surface but they are directly connected in their objective of ending the American system of government. For that reason, it seems to this writer that John Stokes was a perfect foil for MHRN. His rhetoric and behavior were so over the top that he served as good recruitment tool for MHRN.

Stokes was angry about central planning of their local economy (sustainable development community planning)

In 1994, shortly after moving to Lake County from Washington, Stokes got involved in destroying the efforts of the **Canyon Master Plan**, a citizen-initiated plan for growth

control. His threatening and abusive tactics prompted citizens to file letters with the County Commissioners pleading that something be done to ensure their safety. The Canyon Master Plan was in Flathead County. Stokes didn't even live in the same county. We have scanned some of the letters for you to read.

The lie was that the master plan was not citizen-initiated. It was government promoted central economic planning. The master plans for all counties and cities were cookie cutter plans – boiler plate that was simply customized for the local area. Citizens were facilitated using the Delphi technique to believe that the planning was their idea and their plan.
